## DIRECTIONS FOR FILLING OUT TRANSFER APPLICATION AND/OR BREEDERS CERTIFICATE

Every change in ownership must be promptly recorded with the World Watusi Association so that progeny of the animal may be registered and subsequent changes in ownership recorded. Open transfers are condemned and considered a poor practice. THE ASSOCIATION LOOKS TO THE SELLER TO promptly complete transfers, in every detail, pay the appropriate fee and send all relevant documents and payments to the Registrar after the sale transaction is completed.

All writing must be in ink or typewritten. Do not use pencil. Applications that have been altered are not acceptable. If a mistake is made, use another blank application.

If transaction involves the sale of a cow of any breed which is bred to a registered Watusi bull, the Transfer Application and/or Breeders Certificate is still to be completed.

The original certificate of registration must accompany this transfer application along with the appropriate fee.

- 1. Indicate sex of animal to be transferred.
- 2. Print name of the animal to be transferred, its private herd number and WWA number.
- 3. Print name of the new owner and complete address of the new owner as it shall appear on the certificate of registration.
- 4. Signature of person who is shown as the present owner on the certificate of registration of the animal to be transferred.
- 5. Indicate month, day and year the new owner took delivery of the animal.
- 6. If animal to be transferred was artificially inseminated, indicate month, day and year of insemination along with the A.I. bull's name, WWA number and A.I. certification number.
- 7. (a) If animal to be transferred was naturally serviced by one bull, indicate the dates of exposure and the name and WWA number of the bull used in natural service.

  (b) If serviced by multiple bulls, complete and submit a DNA Parentage Certificate upon birth.
- 8. Print name of the breeder (person who owned the cow at the time of service) as it shall appear on the certificate of registration.
- 9. Print full address of the breeder as it shall appear on the certificate of registration.
- 10. Signature of breeder and date breeder signed the breeders certificate
- 11. Indicate whether the certificate of registration and copy of the breeders certificate is to be returned to the new owner or seller..
