

# HORN MEASUREMENT STANDARD OF THE WORLD WATUSI ASSOCIATION

## **COMPOSITE HORN MEASUREMENT SCORE**

#### **Greatest Possible Length (GPL):**

Taken at any point along a continuous line from the hairline to the tip, using whichever location gives the greatest possible length, whether top, bottom or side.

#### **Greatest Possible Circumference (GPC):**

Taken at the widest possible point on the horn, regardless of location.

#### **Mid-Point Circumference (MPC):**

Taken at the exact halfway point from the hairline to the horn tip, or at one-half of the GPL.


## **ADDITIONAL HORN MEASUREMENTS**

#### **Total Horn Length (THL):**

Taken along the top of the horn and crossing over the top of the head from horn tip to horn tip, while staying in constant contact with the horn and head.

## Tip to Tip (TTT):

Distance measured in a straight line from one horn tip to the other.

## **ANIMAL HORN STYLE REFERENCE**

As accurately as possible - Draw in horn shape



#### NOTE:

Released April 2018

This measurement standard applies to all intact animals, live or deceased. Skulls may be measured using the end of the horn cap in place of the hairline reference point, provided the horn cap has not receded. All skulls must be measured by no less than two members of the WWA Measurement Committee to obtain an "Official Score", whereas intact animals require only one. A WWA Official Horn Measurement Representative must perform the measurement to be recorded with the WWA as an "Official Score." For any horn measurement questions, please contact an Official Horn Measurement Representative.

An "Official Score" cannot be recorded by the animal's owner, or by anyone of the same entity.
